Option 1: Research the effects of the industrial revolution. Poor and crowded living conditions during the Industrial Revolution led to the spread of many illnesses, including cholera. Research the causes, symptoms, and treatments for cholera. Then, create a public service campaign to educate the masses about the illness. This can include posters, brochures, commercials, etc.

Option 2: Research the Agricultural Revolution – Why did the Agriculture Revolution take place? What areas improved the most (agriculture, animal, food, etc.)? Which inventions aided in the Agriculture Revolution and how so? What were the positive and negative effects of the Agriculture Revolution?

Option 3: Research different inventions of the Industrial Revolution. Identify 6-10 inventions. Name of the invention. Who was the inventor? Why did the inventor want to invent this invention? What was the function of the invention, description of the invention? How did the invention improve or change how things were done? What did the invention replace? What was the lasting impact of the invention; explain how it has affected our lives/society? Evolution of the invention, upgrades.

Option 4: Research Child Labor Background of Child Labor during the Industrial Revolution. Jobs or positions children held. What ages were desirable for specific positions and why? What were the issue with Child Labor? Why does child labor exist? What are the causes of child labor? Laws created to support and laws created to prevent child labor.

Or any other Research topic that has been approved by Mr. Benitez

Requirements for different types of projects

Power point – Must have a title page, 12 slides of information & one picture on each slide, and a work cited page with 5 citations (only if you did not do a level 4 power point for mt1)

Research paper – Must be 5 full pages typed and have a work cited page with 5 citations

Brochure – Must have title page, inside information laid out in an organized fashion, have pictures/graphs and have 5 citations on the back

Newsletter- Front, inside and back, must have 7-8 articles and pictures and 5 citations on the back page

Or any other type of evidence that has been approved by Mr. Benitez
